Have you noticed recently the emphasis on Home Health documentation either in ADRs or MAC communications? It's an old health care saying - but it still rings true – *“If it's not documented, it's not done!”* Some would also add, *“If it's documented, but not legible or signed appropriately, it's not done!”*

This 90 minute webinar will focus on:

1. Brief overview of who is looking at your documentation and its need to support your claims and indicate COP compliance
 2. Getting & documenting the clinical info you need at the point of referral to assist ICD-10 coding
 3. Documenting Homebound status
 4. Documenting medical necessity by focusing on 5 major Home Health coverage areas: wounds; injections; teaching; diabetes; and observation and assessment
 5. POC Documentation needs including diagnosis decision making; what medications to include; and, POC statements re: daily skilled nursing; anticipated length of stay in home health; management & evaluation narrative; and, therapy goals.

 7. Signature requirements
 8. and How to make documentation corrections per CMS requirements
