1. COP Med List
  - a. How are people handling co-signing of med list under COP
  - b. Co- signing for therapy only admission
  - c. QA nurses review meds on admission (or within window)
  - d. If Patient has a representative, you don't need to mail anything
  - e. Patient has a right to info on the device of their choice
2. State survey
  - a. Looking at Evacuation as part as Emergency Plan
  - b. Tracking Home Health Aide-
    - i. weekly tracking, excel or similar
    - ii. Schedule out 10-12 days to ensure it falls within 14
    - iii. Currently floating at 97%
3. Patient plan of care documented
  - a. Written proof, in the nurses notes
  - b. Not necessary to print and deliver
  - c. Have printed regulation handy

## Next Meeting Meeting

Bring QAPI plan, Dashboard with indicators and board approved written plan, if you are comfortable doing so. The QIO has access to agency information, but often that data seems old.

- What are key indicators your agency is looking at?
- What is significant in your CASPER report
- Who is your scrubber? (SHP, OCS, BrightTree)
- How does that data drive your daily work
- There is so much data. Which specific characteristic reports are you looking at?
- Which process measures?
